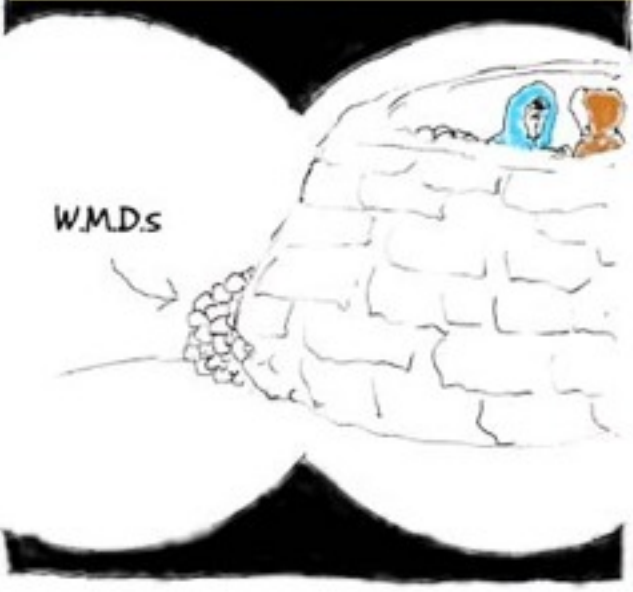
Based on a true story

I wonder if Grandma's cookies are done...

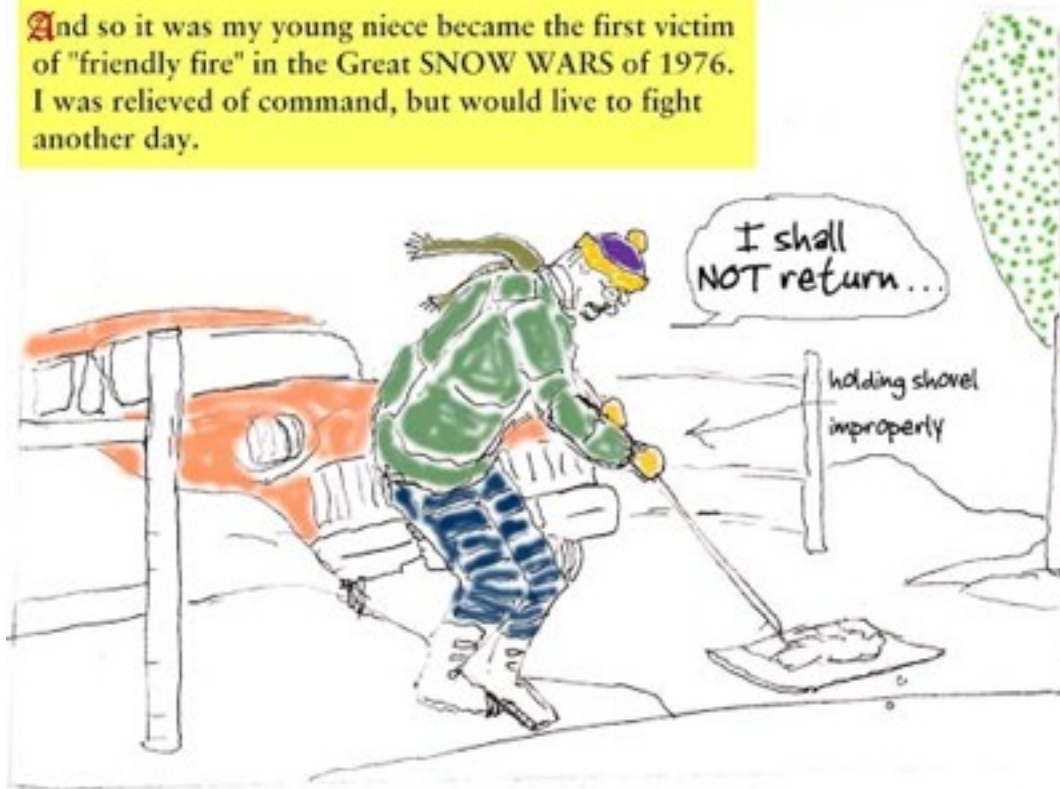
However, any snow war vet will tell you that frontal attack is pure SUICIDE unless diversional tactics are employed... usually from the flank.
